
PRODUCT PROFILE + HS CODE:

PACKAGING MATERIALS

Paperboard is the most used packaging material, accounting for around a third of world packaging markets consumption. Followedby flexible packaging at 25.5 percent, rigid plastics at 18.7 per cent and metal at 12.1per cent glass packaging for 5.8 percent.
